

Activity Curriculum

Introduction

Objective

Domains of Activity Curriculum

5. Leadership

Content of the program

- Students should complete the 5 domains throughout the six years(from F1 to F6)
- Each student has to select one or two domains to be fulfilled and fill in the application form at the Mid-October every year.
- Each student has to fulfill at least 8 hours of the claimed domain every year.

Procedures

1. Distribution of application form to students at the end of October.
2. According to the internal and external activities, students must select one or two domains and fill in the application form.
3. Students must hand in the application form to Monitress at the beginning of November.
4. Approved and Data entry by school
5. Data checking by students in March
6. Confirmation of the activity hours by tutors(external activity) and teachers(internal activity)
